

Regulations Governing the Alumni Scholarship for Economically Disadvantaged Students in the College of Management at National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University

Formulated at the 4th administrative directors meeting of the College of Management for academic year 2020 on Jan 4, 2021
Passed at the 3rd administrative directors meeting of the College of Management for academic year 2021 on Nov 1, 2021

Article 1 To encourage students in the College of Management at National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University (hereinafter the University or NYCU) who are economically disadvantaged or have experienced sudden financial difficulties to pursue their studies, enthusiastic alumni have donated to the College to establish the "Alumni Scholarship for Economically Disadvantaged Students in the College of Management at National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University."

Article 2 Applicable to: Students who are citizens of Taiwan and are enrolled in Year 2 or above in any undergraduate department of the College of Management.

Article 3 Eligibility:

1. Exceptional circumstances (e.g. low-income households, physically and mentally challenged or economically disadvantaged, sudden family emergencies or other special reasons).
2. An overall average of 70 or above in academic performance in the previous academic year.
3. Not receiving any other scholarships.
4. Recommended by a tutor/advisor or department head.

Article 4 Documents Required for Application:

Applicants should complete an application form together with a photocopy of the following documentation:

1. A copy of the academic transcript of the previous academic year, a letter of recommendation from a teacher, and a certificate of outstanding performance or representative deeds.
2. A photocopy of household registration certificate, autobiography and proof of family finances (proof of income tax return for the whole household, proof of low-income household, proof of income tax exemption, statement of sudden financial hardship or other supporting documents).

Article 5 Scholarship Scheme: Two places per academic year from 2021 to 2025, at NT\$50,000 each. The total amount of the scholarship is NT\$500,000 for five years, and whether the scholarship can be continued after five years is subject to continued support from any enthusiastic alumni.

Article 6 Application Period: Applications should be made to the departmental

offices within one month of new school year registration in the first semester of each academic year.

Article 7 Any unused scholarship places in each academic year will be reserved for the next semester.

Article 8 This scholarship will be reviewed and approved by an administrative directors meeting of the College of Management before being awarded.

Article 9 These Regulations shall come into operation upon approval by an administrative directors meeting of the College of Management, and the same applies to any subsequent amendments hereto.
